Our presenter, Robert Pavlis, shared hints and tricks to make growing orchids easy. Key Learnings included:

- Don't be Too nice, they're tougher than you think!
- Don't over water- use the finger test, if dry.... Wait 2 more days!
- No Special Fertilizer required
- Re-pot every 2 years, removing all old "soil", moss and dead roots. Use coconut husk if possible.
- Once flowering, don't reposition
 His ideas made it very encouraging to try growing such gorgeous plants!

the date is now July 29, 30, and 31.


